



Bronson Memorial Cemetery Rules & Regulations

REVISED NOVEMBER 13, 2017

1. Lots shall be used for no other purpose than the burial of the human dead.
2. All lots shall be sold with the provision for perpetual care.
3. The City Office will issue a deed with the purpose of each lot.
4. As provided by law, interments or removals must be previously authorized by proper official permit. Such permit must also be accompanied by the Charged for the opening and closing of the grave.
5. Placement of mausoleums shall be controlled by the City.
6. No enclosure of any kind, such as a fence, coping, hedge, or ditch, shall be permitted around any grave or lot. Grave mounds will not be allowed and no lot shall be raised above the established grade.
7. In the best interest of the Cemetery, no trees, shrubbery, or plants shall be planted without consent of the City Office.
8. The Bronson City Council shall have absolute charge of the Cemetery and is authorized to enforce the rules and regulations.
9. All monument and marker foundations must be approved by the City Office.
10. Cemetery grounds are cleared of all winter coverings around the first Monday of April. All summer coverings are cleared around the first Monday of November. All broken urns will be disposed of. Any urn unused for a period of three years will be disposed of.
11. Flags may be placed one week before Memorial Day, Independence Day and Armistice Day, Flags that are frayed, faded or torn will be removed immediately.
12. No intoxicating beverages permitted on grounds.
13. Please clean up after your pets.
14. No smoking on grounds.
15. All burials (including cremations) must utilize a vault made of non-biodegradable materials. Excepted from this rule are non-cremation baby burials that utilize a baby casket with attached vault.
